Bald eagles and gulls feast on shellfish along the shoreline, while boaters reel in their share from the waters. The beach is a peaceful yet vibrant haven—an oceanside paradise for both wildlife and the community that calls it home.

Nature's Bounty

Watch boats cruise by or head out yourself to catch fresh crab, salmon, shrimp, or squid. When the tide goes out, locals gather to harvest clams along the shoreline. Kids love exploring the beach for barnacled rocks, seashells, sea stars, jellyfish, seaweed, and driftwood. Onamac is the perfect place for making lasting memories —where children spend hours turning over rocks to find crabs and splashing in the calm summer waters.





Camping Fun

Onamac homeowners enjoy exclusive access to four reservable campsites near Onamac Point, each equipped with sturdy wood picnic tables and grated fire pits —perfect for hosting BBQs and beachside bonfires with friends. The private boat launch is available to members of the Onamac Maintenance Association, who can also extend access to their quests.

Onamac Community

Members of the Onamac Maintenance Association meet monthly to discuss community updates, including water treatment, the Onamac newsletter, and upcoming beach events. Summer brings neighborhood-wide garage sales—a fun way to connect with neighbors, hunt for treasures, and earn a little extra cash. Onamac Point is also available for residents to reserve for larger gatherings, such as wedding receptions and special events.





Stunning Views

Sunsets and sunrises over the water in Onamac are nothing short of breathtaking —gold and amber hues blend into vibrant oranges, soft pinks, and lavender pastels. After storms, double rainbows often light up the sky, and on clear days, the Olympic Mountains create a stunning backdrop across Saratoga Passage. To the north, Mt.
